

# **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

#### Introduction

Patrons and visitors attending Jubilee Park Stadium and/or outdoor netball courts (collectively **Stadium**) must comply with all laws, regulations, directions and rules issued by government or any government authority or Frankston & District Netball Association (**FDNA**) staff (or delegate) while this facility is managed FDNA, under authority of Frankston City Council (**FCC**).

For the comfort, safety and enjoyment of all patrons, staff and participants, entry to this venue is subject to the following Conditions of Entry.

#### 1. Prohibited Items

The following items are not permitted in the Stadium (indoor or outdoor):

- Bicycles, scooters, skateboards and rollerblades/skates
- Illegal substances, including controlled, dangerous or illicit drugs
- Incendiary devices, including flares, fireworks and smoke bombs
- Firearms and explosives, chemical, radioactive or biological substances
- Laser lights
- Alcohol
- Animals (other than assistance dogs)
- Chairs/stools
- Glass (including bottles)
- Any other item that in the opinion of management, could cause harm or public nuisance.

### 2. Alcohol

The indoor venue at the Stadium is licensed and as such, the following provisions apply:

- Alcoholic beverages must not be taken into or from the venue
- Intoxicated persons will be refused entry/ evicted from the venue(s)
- Alcohol may only be consumed in designated areas and at times authorised by FDNA
- It is an offence for minors to purchase or consume alcohol, or for a person to supply alcohol to a minor.
- Breaches of these laws may result in eviction from the venue and the persons being reported to the Police (penalties apply under the *Liquor Control Reform Act* 1998).

## 3. Smoking

Smoking and/or vaping is not permitted inside the Stadium or anywhere on the grounds managed by FDNA. FDNA reserves the right to ask smokers to relocate to a designated smoking area.

## 4. Restrictions on Entry

FDNA reserves the right to refuse entry to any person or to remove any person from the Stadium.

# 5. Ejection from Venue

A person may be ejected from the venue where that person:

- Breaches the Child Safety Standards and/or
- Breaches the Victorian Government Fair Play Code or Netball Australia Member Protection Policy or Netball Victoria Codes of Conduct and/or
- Uses foul or abusive language or makes discriminatory or threatening remarks or gestures and/or
- Is deemed by FDNA Staff to be displaying offensive, disorderly or unlawful behaviour and/or
- Enters the venue or other restricted internal area without proper authorisation;
   and/or
- Fails to comply with these conditions of entry or a lawful request from FDNA Staff and/or
- Any person/s identified by FDNA Staff to be engaged in any practice considered to be involved with transmitting information from sporting events for the purpose of gambling

### 6. Other Conditions

- Patrons and visitors are advised that the Stadium is fitted with CCTV electronic surveillance and patrons may be filmed in any public area of the Stadium (refer CCTV Policy).
- Patrons and visitors enter the Stadium at their own risk. FDNA management has
  no liability for any damaged, lost or stolen property nor for any other loss,
  damage or injury suffered by any patron, whether in contract, tort or statutory
  liability to the full extent permitted by law.
